The palate is supple and smooth, with fine tannins, and a successful integration of 25% new oak for the 12 month aging. Some “micro-oxygenation” - sending fine bubbles through the barrels - has broken down the tannins a bit more, and it works here.”

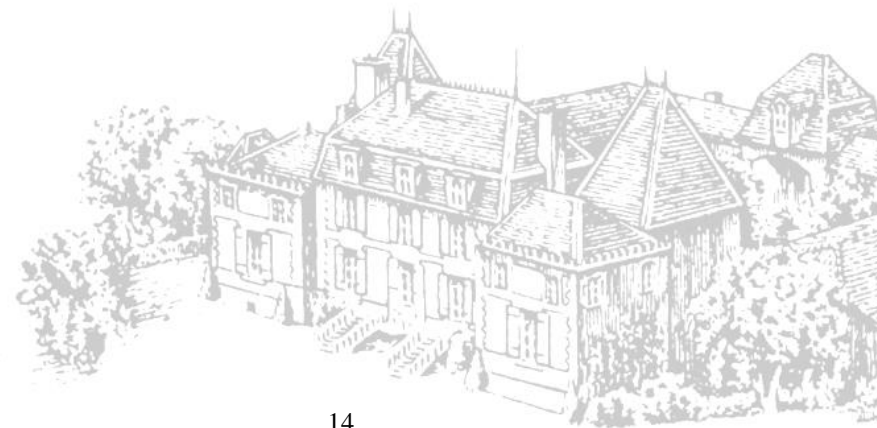
